COVID-19 Measures

During the current COVID-19 pandemic the health and safety of all participants at ISU Events including the athletes, team members, officials, volunteers, service providers, broadcasters, media, and spectators needs to be given additional attention. The [Guidelines for ISU Events during the COVID-19 Pandemic](#) and the [Sport Specific Annex – Speed Skating](#) describe the minimum sanitary measures that must be put in place to host an ISU Event during the COVID-19 pandemic.

These Guidelines do not, in any case, supersede additional requirements established by the National or Local Public Health Authorities of the hosting country which must be implemented in full, in particular regarding the physical distancing, hereby a minimum of 1,5 meters, but which may vary from country to country and the number of people allowed by square meter. The instructions and sanitary requirements outlined in this document will be continuously updated, as necessary, and every accredited person needs to fully comply with the respective policy and any additional instructions given by the ISU Event Management Team and/or ISU Medical Commission Member onsite.

Pre-conditions on attending an ISU Event for all on-site media

In order for any media accreditation request to be considered members of the media must:

1. Read the Guidelines for ISU Events during the COVID-19 pandemic – For the Media [Guidelines for ISU Events during the COVID-19 Pandemic](#) and the [Sport Specific Annex – Speed Skating](#).
2. Sign the [Waiver for Attendees of ISU Events during COVID-19 Pandemic](#).
3. Present the necessary documentation requested by the Organizing Committee
4. Apply for media accreditation via the relevant link provided for each event below..

The number of media accreditations issued per event will be restricted and will depend on the venue and the restrictions of the host nation. Priority will be given to media residing in the host nation.

The ISU will not be held responsible for any travel restriction or delay, even if an accreditation request has been approved.
